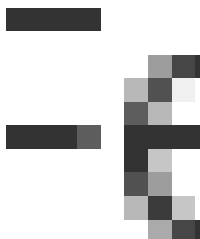
### **TEA COMMITTEE EMERGENCY SUBSTITUTE LIST:**
